

# Day trip Arusha National Park

For those who do not have the time to do a multi-day safari in the large park in the northwest, a day trip to Arusha National Park is a delightful way to get a taste of safari feeling.



It is an about one hour drive from the Lodge Kaliwa to the park. Yes, there is only a very small chance to see larger predators and elephants. But you can watch here buffaloes, giraffes, zebras, gazelles and warthogs and marvel at the black and white colobus monkeys, one usually rarely seen in the northern national parks.



The Arusha National Park is beautiful nestled between Mt. Meru, with 4565 meters fifth highest mountain Tansanias, and the Momella lakes that often reside large flamingo flocks. Delightful is the view of the 400-meter-deep Ngurdoto crater.

Our day trip includes travel with an experienced guide in a four wheel drive safari vehicle with pop up roof. Lunchbox and 1.5 liters of water per person will satisfy hunger and thirst.

Start will be in the morning at 9am, return to the lodge usually is between 5 and 6pm.
